The project management-orientated labour force in seven project orientated sectors is expected to grow by 33 percent, or nearly 22 million new jobs, through 2027 (PMI)

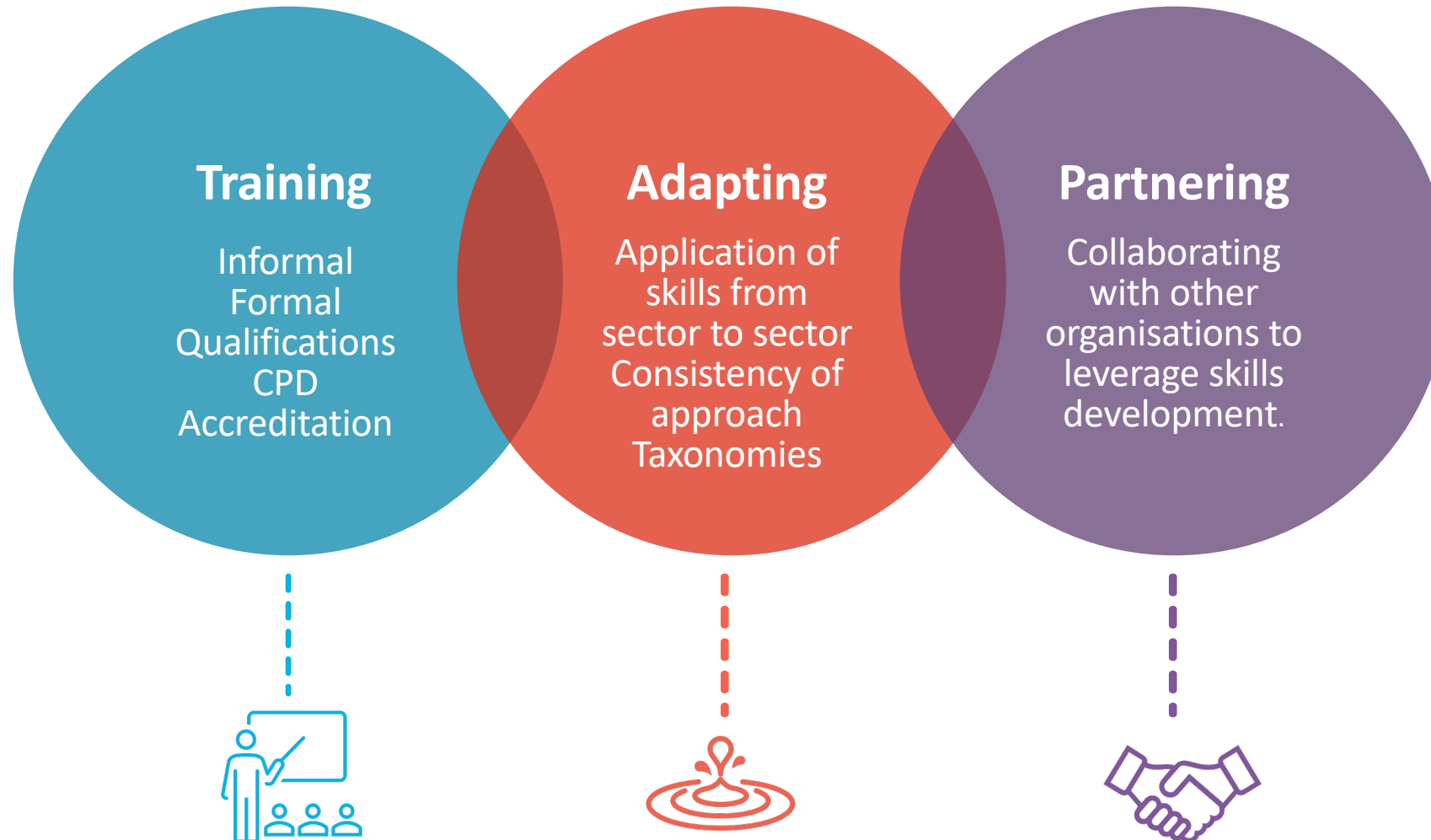

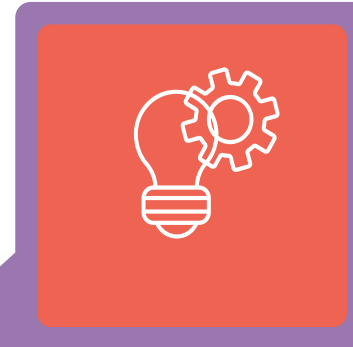

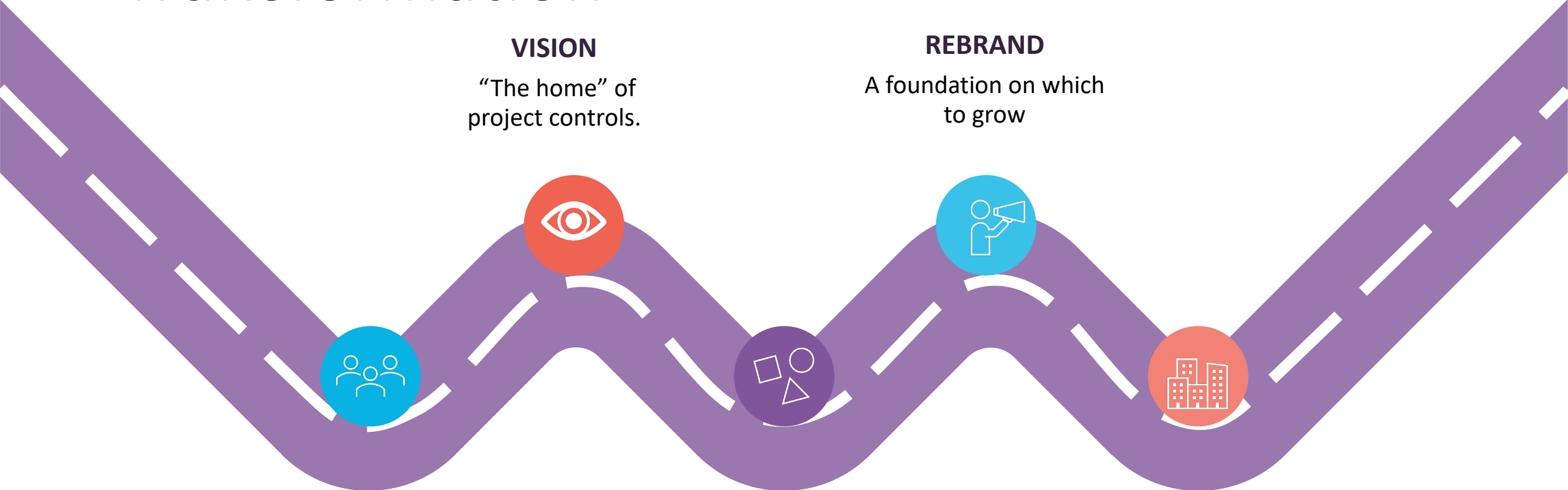
